- 3) <u>Pair of tweezers -- any you like</u> <u>Kim's Favorite Tweezers - Non-Locking (mosaicsmalti.com)</u>
- 4) <u>N95 mask for use while mixing mortar</u>
- 5) <u>OPTIONAL BRING MOSAIC TOOLS IF YOU HAVE THEM (Glass and tile nippers, mosaic hammer, dental pick)</u>
- 6) <u>Scissors</u>
- 7) Palette knives
- 8) Small cheap paint brush
- 9) Any person tools you wish to use (Optional)
- 10) Sketch book/Pencil
- 11) Reusable water bottle
- 12) <u>Apron</u>
