**Agnes & James Kinard Scholarship (Due March 15)**

This scholarship provides 100% tuition for any adult-level workshop to veterans and immediate family members of veterans and/or members of the Associated Artists of Pittsburgh. Additional funds may be awarded to offset the cost of housing, meals, travel, and materials fees on a case-by-case basis. In 2020 most of these awards will be given to individuals seeking to participate in the Frontline Paper workshop for Veterans.

**Architecture and the Integrity of Craft Scholarship (Due March 15)**

This scholarship provides up to \$1,200 towards any adult-level workshop's tuition, room, and board. Recipients must reside on campus and take part in the full meal plan during their workshop. Eligible candidates include any student who has completed at least 2 years in an NCARB accredited architectural program or a recent graduate of an NCARB accredited program who is 30yrs old or younger. Submission of a Resume/Bio including awards, recognitions, and certifications is required to be considered for this award.

**Educators' Retreat Scholarship (Due March 15)**

This scholarship provides 50%-100% tuition for any Educators' Retreat workshop. K-12 educators & those studying to be educators are eligible.

**General Scholarship (Due March 15)**

This scholarship provides 50% - 100% tuition for any adult-level workshop.

**Susan M. Brimo-Cox Memorial Scholarship (Due March 15)**

This scholarship provides up to \$500 towards any adult-level workshop's tuition, room, and board. Scholarship recipients will be required to donate one small object from their workshop to help document the impact of the Susan Brimo-Cox family's commemorative contribution made in her honor. A preference is given to veterans and their immediate family members.

**Thaddeus Mosley Scholarship (Due March 15)**

This scholarship provides 100% tuition for any adult-level sculpture-based workshop. Additional funds may be awarded to offset the cost of housing, meals, travel and materials fees on a case-by-case basis. This scholarship was established in honor of lifelong Touchstone instructor and friend, Thaddeus Mosley.
