- 1) Safety glasses (preferably with 99% UV protection; clear lens acceptable) (Touchstone has if you do not have)

- 2) Saw frame with 4" minimum throat depth (Touchstone has if you do not have)

- 3) Needle files (set of 6 or set of 12)

- 4) 6" half round file, approx. 0 cut and/or 2 cut

- 5) Pliers: chain-nose, flat-nose, round nose

- 6) Tweezers with fine points

- 7) Soldering pick (coat hanger is fine)

- 8) Silver solder – wire: 1' each of hard, medium, easy or sheet: 1x 1" (or equivalent size) of hard, medium, easy solder silver

9) Flux brush (inexpensive, natural hair)

10) 6 x ½" flexible metal ruler

11) Liquid paper or yellow ochre

12) Saw blades: size 2/0 or nearest size available, 4-6 dozen

13) Larger file such as 6-10" half-round, barrette or flat files

14) Metal scribe or x-acto knife

15) Silicon carbide sandpaper: 1 sheet each of 220 or 240, 400 and 600 grits

16) Notebook/sketchbook

19) Vernier gauge or digital calipers

20) Respirator with dust filter

21) Sharpie marker with med. – thick tip

22) Drill index(es): 1-60, 61-80

23) Cutting broaches

24) Separating discs with mandrels

25) Super glue

26) Parallel-action pliers

27) Joint vise/mitre cutter #126.499

28) Hand-held sawing jig #126.448
