1) Paint Brushes, soft sable, various sizes (S/M/L), no larger than 1".

Purchase through: You can buy a small set for under \$5 at most craft stores.

2) Dust Masks

Purchase through: Any hardware store

3) FINE POINT Sharpie

Purchase through: Any office supply store

4) Graphite #2 Pencil

Purchase through: Anywhere office supplies are sold

5) Sketch book/ Notepad

Purchase through: Various sources, art/craft store, office supply store, amazon, etc.

6) Containers for enamels

Purchase through: the beading section at most art/craft supply stores

7) Any precious metals/materials/tools that you may have used in a previous metalsmithing workshop, i.e.: sheet and wire scraps, etc. Additionally, please bring ANY materials (for example: fabric, paper, or botanical in nature) that are aesthetically pleasing to you. We want to find inspiration for you first foray into enameling!
